Step 1. Environment Check

• Open this link: Environment Check Tool

Step 2. Screen Recording

• We may use different screen recording application:

For Windows

- **Snipping Tool** (built-in, Windows 11) → easiest, since no install needed.
- **Xbox Game Bar** → press Win + G, built-in on Windows 10/11.
- **OBS Studio** → free, professional (but a bit complex).

For Mac

- QuickTime Player (built-in) → File > New Screen Recording.
- Shortcut: Command + Shift + 5 → start screen recording directly.

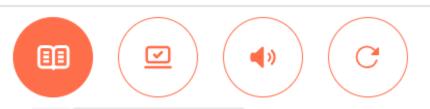
(No Install)

- **Loom** (browser extension / app, free for short recordings)
- ScreenApp.io (web-based recorder).
- Open Snipping Tool.
- Select the Record button → New, or press Windows logo key + Shift + R.
- Highlight the area of the screen you want to record.

Step 3. Record Environment Check

While on the Environment Check Tool:

- Open Camera and Microphone.
- Click all four icons on the **upper right part** of the screen.



Confirm that all devices are working properly.

Step 4. Submit Recording
